Madasmy about the 14 Speakers of KANININAR SERIES" and meeting kit were provided to all by the Treasurer . EC Members were given with a copy of printed AGM Booklet. Welcome drink was served.
- 2) The General Body meeting was called to order by the President at 11 A.M. As the meeting was commenced after half an hour to the scheduled time, the strength of members present were more than the Qurom required, The meeting commenced with Invocation Song. President Mr.N.Karthikeyan, welcomed the gathering. In his welcome address, he also sought for the suggestions of members to further scale up the activities of CYSI.

- ◆ So far Mr. Vivekanandan, EC member has introduced 55 Life Members to CYSI. In appreciation of his this tremendous efforts, he was facilitated in a separate meeting arranged for this purpose.
- ◆ 4EC meetings and 1AGM were conducted during the previous year.
- ◆ The Annual Report presented by the Secretary was unanimously approved by the General body.
- 5) Followed by this, the Treasurer Mr.S.Chokalingam, presented the Audited Accounts along with Auditors Report for the financial year 2021-22. He read out the various Accounts in detail. Thereafter, the General Body approved the Audited Accounts.















Annual Report of the Secretary, CySI for the year 2022-23.

Respected CySI Members,

Greetings to All!

Good Morning

We are happy to present the Annual Report of CySI for the year 2022-2023 before you in the AGM. The outgoing Office Bearers/Executive Committee Members, have taken charge on 05.09. 2021 and handing over the charge to the New Executive Committee Members on this day 23.07.2023. We have held the office for a period of 23 months. We have immense pleasure in furnishing the details of activities and our services from 01.04.2022 to till date.

On 16.04.2022 we have conducted a physical programme on the title of cheated by online fraudsters at Dr.MGR Janaki College of Arts and Science for Women. Cyber Crime Division was the Chief Guest for the event and Dr.Amaresh Pujari, IPS, DGP delivered the Inaugural Address. The Guest Speakers were Tmt.D.Shanmugapriya, IPS S.P. Cyber Crime Division, Mr.S. Harikrishnan G.M.-RBI (Retd.) & Former Vigilance Officer, Regional Head TN RCU & Vigilance IDFC FIRST Bank Ltd., Mr.A.J. Attanathi, Mr.L.Muralidharan, Mr.Hameed, Program Head Newsglitz, Mr.KM Vijayakumar - Vice President CySI, Mr.V.N.Prem Anand- Vice President CySI, and Life Members of CySI -Mr.P.Raman, Mr.B.Kandasamy, Mr.R.Srinivasan, Mr.A.Vinoth Kumar. Mr.N.Karthikeyan President CySI gave the Welcome Address, Mr. Balu Swaminathan -Past President CySI gave the Thematic Address, and Mr.V.S.Sooriyan EC Member CySI delivered the Vote of Thanks. Mrs. Jayashri Sridhar and Mr.K.Kumaran - Joint Secretary CySI compered the sessions. EC Members and Life Members of CySI, Faculty Members and Students of Dr.MGR Janaki College and Invitees participated and benefitted awareness on topics like jack juicing, SIM swapping, SIM cloning, Scam through QR code scan & remedial measures, frauds using online sales platform, etc. The question & answer session was interactive with a large number of queries raised and doubts clarified. Participant Certificates were issued to the registered participants. Delivering the Inaugural Address, Mr. Amaraesh Pujari, Director General of Police, Cyber Crime Division, Chennai provided an overview of the extent of loss inflicted due to cyber-crime in our country and pointed out that more than Rs. 12 crores is lost with damages suffered by more than 80 websites every day in India. He reiterated the current facility for recovering the loss due to cyber frauds wherein there is an assured possibility to recover the lost money if the victims can dial 1930 within 5 minutes of the occurrence. He also stressed the need for strengthening the laws relating to cybercrimes and urged the government to take the needful policy decision towards that end. As a useful tip for the clients, he suggested to the banks to send free SMS alerting on the existence of the 1930 free dialling facility which can a prove a boon for those falling victims to cyber frauds. Mr. Amaraesh Pujari also recommended to the government to consider including lessons in schools which can bring about awareness on cyber-crimes as a means







for safeguarding the future generation from cyber fraudsters. Tmt. D. Shanmuga Priya IPS, Superintendent of Police, Cyber Crimes spoke on prevention and detection of online fraudsters by Cyber Crime Division and Mr Karthikeyan, President spoke on the laws relating to cyber-crimes.

On 17.12.2022 we along with Exnora International, and the Spin Chennai jointly awarded 'Lifetime Achievement' award to four officials who worked on the first landmark case that addressed cyber-harassment. The awardees were D. Arulraj, retired District Judge who awarded the first conviction in a cybercrime case, S. Balu, Addl. Superintendent of Police (Retd), who investigated Suhas Katti and Uma Shankar case which recorded first conviction and first adjudication in cyberspace, Na. Vijayashankar (Naavi), cyber consultant and witness for placing his report with Section 65B IEA in the case, and S. Kothandaraman, Spl. Public Prosecutor (Retd), in Suhas Katti case. The Chennai Cyber Crime cell obtained the conviction within a record time of seven months after the FIR was filed. The conviction was also confirmed by the Session Court in 2008. Justice D. Bharatha Chakravarthy, Judge, High Court of Madras, the guest of honor at the event, presented the awards.

On 20.05.2023 we have organized a panel discussion on Section 65B of Indian Evidence Act at Anna Centenary Library, Kotturpuram, Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

This provision is important in the digital age as it relates to Electronic Evidence in legal proceedings. Mr.VN.Premanand, Vice President of CySI delivered the welcome address. The Chief Guest and Panel Head Dr. A.Thiyagarajan - Senior Advocate - Madras High Court set the context for Section 65B of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 to address the widespread use of electronic records and the conditions and procedures for admission of electronic evidence in court. Subsequently, Panel Head asked Panellists to talk on user, Technical, Legal and overall perspective. From the Panellists, Mr. Balu Swaminathan, talked about User perspective of this section and shared his real-time experience of the cases he handled while working as an investigation officer in the Cyber Crime Unit. Mr. KM. Vijayakumar gave a presentation on the technical aspects of this section covering electronic data, computer output and computers and the recent CERT-IN directive. Mr.N. Karthikeyan addressed the legal aspects related to the history of Section 65B and cited some recent judgments based on Section 65B. And finally, Mr. Na. Vijayashankar, Chairman, FDPPI, outlined the overall view of Section 65B, including how to interpret with various sections, and shared his experience as an expert witness in signing 65B certificates in certain cases. Mr.K.Kumaran, Joint Secretary of CySI delivered the vote of thanks and Master of Ceremony for this programme was done by Mrs. Adhilakshmi Logamurthy, Advocate - Madras High Court. The workshop was attended by around 125 participants, including Police Officers from Chennai Police, Cyber Crime Wing of Tamil N du State, Government Prosecutors, Advocates, Cybercrime unit Police officers, Retired officers from Govt, Law students and IT / Cybersecurity professionals. Media also covered the







Programme. This Panel discussion topic was very well received by participants and received good feedback.

On 25.09.2022 18th AGM was conducted and audited CySI accounts was approved and the documents and the declaration specified in the law were filed before the Registrar of societies. The Civil Suit filed by one Member questioning the show cause notice issued on him by the Secretary before the Additional District Munsiff Court in 05 NO 186/2020 against Cyber Society of India was defended well and the discharge petition filed by us allowed. His plaint was rejected as per provisions under order 7 rule 11(a) of CPC.

We have conducted regular EC Meetings apart from one AGM. Programme posters and AGM photos are available in the website & Youtube link. As usual, auditor report is also incorporated.

Two new Life Members were inducted.

yber Society of India organised a seminar on cyber crime at Dr. MGR Janaki College of Arts & Science for Women. According to a press release, the aim of the programme was to create awareness about online fraudsters and cyber crimes.

N. Karthikeyan, the society's president welcomed the gathering. In his inaugural address, Amaraesh Pujari, Director General of Police, Cyber Crime Division - Chennai, gave an overview of the extent of cyber crimes occurring in the country. He mentioned about the helpline number 1930 which attends to cyber crimes. He said that if a victim calls 1930 within five minutes of the occurrence of the crime the probability to recover the lost money is more. He also suggested that banks can play a role in creating awareness about the helpline number by sending free SMS to their customers.

D. Shanmuga Priya, Superintendent of Police, Cyber Crimes, spoke about prevention of online crimes.

Balu Swaminathan, former president of the society, briefed the laws pertaining to cyber crimes

Further, victims of online frauds shared their experiences. It ranged from frauds in sales platforms, due to use of unverified mobile apps, phishing, impersonation on social platforms, SIM swapping or cloning, scams through QR codes, frauds using screen sharing, ATM card skimming and many more, adds the release.

Delivering the Inaugural Address, Mr. Amaraesh Pujari, Director General of Police, Cyber Crime Division, Chennai provided an overview of the extent of loss inflicted due to cyber-crime in our country and pointed out that more than Rs. 12 crores is lost with damages suffered by more than 80 websites every day in India. He reiterated the current facility for recovering the loss due to cyber frauds wherein there is an assured

possibility to recover the lost money if the victims can dial 1930 within 5 minutes of the occurrence. He also stressed the need for strengthening the laws relating to cyber-crimes and urged the government to take the needful policy decision towards that end. As a useful tip for the clients, he suggested to the banks to send free SMS alerting on the existence of the 1930 free dialling facility which can a prove a boon for those falling victims to cyber

frauds. Mr. Amaraesh Pujari also recommended to the government to consider including lessons in schools which can bring about awareness on cyber-crimes as a means for safeguarding the future generation from cyber fraudsters. Tmt. D. Shanmuga Priya IPS, Superintendent of Police, Cyber Crimes spoke on prevention and detection of online fraudsters by Cyber Crime Division and Mr Karthikeyan, Cyber Advocate spoke on the laws relating to cyber-crimes.
