

### "Overview of the Revised Society Bye-Laws: Purpose and Key Changes"

#### Dear Members,

Cybercrime is rapidly spreading through cyberspace, leaving unsuspecting netizens vulnerable. The most effective way to protect potential victims is through awareness. The Cyber Society of India (CySI), established two decades ago with this very goal in mind, has faced challenges due to a lack of resources and active participation among members. To address these issues, the Bye-laws of CySI have been completely redesigned, maintaining our original objectives.

On 23.05.2024, the Executive Committee set up a committee consisting of a technical expert, a long-standing member who has served in various capacities, and a legal expert. The committee, chaired by Mr. Vijayakumar KM, President, and including Mr. Balu Swaminathan, Secretary, and Mr. S. Balasubramanian, Joint Secretary, has formulated the new Bye-laws. These were presented before the ECM on 01.09.2024 and were unanimously approved. They will now be placed before the AGM for discussion and approval on 29.09.2024.

#### **Key Changes:**

- **1. Objective Retained:** The primary objective of promoting the safe usage of digital communication remains unchanged.
- **2. Objective Refinement:** The objectives have been refined to focus on relevant activities, excluding unrelated ones.
- 3. Simplification: The Bye-laws have been simplified for greater clarity and ease of understanding.
- 4. Content Revision: Irrelevant matters have been removed, and pertinent content has been added.
- **5. Subject Expansion:** Certain topics have been broadened to cover a wider scope.
- **6. Extended Tenure:** The tenure of the Executive Committee (EC) has been extended from 2 years to 3 years.
- **7. Life Membership Rights:** Due to low participation from 99% of Life Members in CySI activities, certain rights have been adjusted to ensure the vitality of CySI.
- **8. Introduction of Live Membership:** A new Live Membership category has been introduced, requiring an annual fee of Rs. 1,000 to encourage active engagement and fund-raising.
- **9. Educational institution Students Chapter:** Educational institution can now enroll students with a one-time payment of Rs. 25,000, promoting student involvement in awareness activities.
- **10. Presidential Powers:** The powers of the President have been clearly defined to eliminate previous ambiguities.
- **11.** Induction of EC Members should be carefully considered to ensure that their involvement aligns with the Society's non- Profit objectives and does not create any conflicts of interest.
- **12. EC Member Involvement:** EC members are required to be active, with clear procedures for termination in place.
- **13. Disciplinary Actions:** Disciplinary actions against EC members can be initiated based on reports from the Secretary.
- **14. Vacancy Provisions:** Procedures for filling EC member vacancies through nomination and subsequent AGM ratification have been established.
- **15. Supportive Behaviour:** The expected conduct of Life, Live, and EC Members has been clearly outlined.
- **16. Fund Availability for CySI Activities:** Future Life Membership fees, Live Membership fees, FD interest, and sponsorship amounts will be utilized to cover expenses related to CySI activities.

#### A. Introduction

The Cyber Society of India (CySI) made significant strides in cybersecurity awareness, education, and collaboration during the financial year 2023-24. Through targeted events, strategic partnerships, and concerted efforts of the Executive Committee, CySI enhanced its presence and relevance in addressing cybercrime challenges in India. This report outlines key activities, events, and achievements for the year, providing a comprehensive overview of the Society's performance.

#### B. PART 1. Events organized by CYSI:-

CySI organized a series of impactful events during the year, each aimed at addressing specific cybersecurity issues and fostering collaborative discussions with experts across various domains:

Event -1-20.05.2023: Panel Discussion on Section 65B of the Indian Evidence Act Venue: Anna Centenary Library

A critical discussion on the legal framework for electronic evidence, featuring over 125 participants including legal experts, IT professionals, and law enforcement officers.

**Event-2-23.07.2023: Compensation to Cyber Victims** 

Venue: Dr. MGR Janaki College

This event (Around 100 participants) also included CySI's Annual General Meeting (AGM) and elections. Key discussions revolved around victim compensation in cybercrime incidents.

**Event-3-02.09.2023: Combating Current Cybercrime Scenarios**

A panel discussion (Around 100 participants) on modern cyber threats, focusing on ransomware and online scams, with expert insights from cybersecurity professionals.

Event-4-03.02.2024: Freezing of Bank Accounts due to Cybercrime

**Venue:** Anna Centenary Library

Discussions covered the operational and legal challenges in freezing bank accounts, with participation from RBI officials, advocates, and cybersecurity experts (Around 100 participants).

#### **Strategic Partnerships and Collaborations**

CySI strengthened its ties with key stakeholders in the field of cybersecurity:

- Collaboration with Tamil Nadu Police Cybercrime Wing: Partnering with law enforcement for events and discussions has been instrumental in bridging the gap between technology, law enforcement, and legal frameworks.
- Expert Involvement: Engaging subject matter experts from various sectors such as law enforcement, legal professions, and IT helped CySI tackle cyber challenges more comprehensively.

#### **Financial Performance Overview**

The induction of 17 new members contributed ₹85,000 to the association, helping CySI maintain a stable financial foundation through effective cost management and strategic event planning.

In a half-day session at IDFC First Bank, Mr. Swaminathan covered vital topics like cyber security and financial frauds for 35 bankers. From 10:00 AM to 1:30 PM, discussions on preventive measures, investigation techniques, and bank frauds took center stage. The session, accompanied by a detailed PowerPoint presentation, was highly interactive with attendees posing insightful questions. The event concluded with felicitations and mementos from the bank's credit managers, acknowledging the session's success.

#### 4. SICCI Conference on Cybersecurity Challenges & Opportunities

Date: April 4, 2024 | Venue: The Park Hotel, Chennai

Speakers: Mr. Balu Swaminathan

At the SICCI Conference, Mr. Balu delivered an impactful presentation on the challenges and opportunities in law enforcement. His dedication to combating cybercrime and post-retirement awareness efforts resonated with the audience. Mr. Balu also introduced the Cyber Society of India (CySI) and proposed future collaborations, garnering appreciation from attendees.

#### Part 3 - 13.07.2024

Electronic Evidence Legislation workshop stressed for continued debate.

The Cyber Society of India (CySI), a non-profit NGO since 2004, hosted a workshop in Chennai on 13.07.2024 to discuss new evidence laws for electronic records under the Bharatiya Sakkhsya Adhiniyam, 2023. The event targeted legal professionals, IT personnel, students, and the general public. Notable speakers included former High Court judges Dr. Justice S. Vimala and Justice Mr. P. N. Prakash, Senior Advocates Dr. A. Thiyagajan, Ms. N.S. Nappinai, Mr. Ajay Singh, Cyber experts Mr. Na Vijayashankar, Mr. Ramesh Venkataraman, Mr. Krishna Sastry Pendadya, Mr. Vijayakumar KM, President and Mr. Balu Swaminathan, Secretary of CySI and others. The workshop emphasized the need to simplify procedures for admitting electronic records, addressing challenges such as hash value discrepancies and certification costs because of engaging an expert. The evolving legal frameworks for











electronic evidence were discussed, stressing the importance of developing practical and simplified procedures for their admission.

#### C. Achievements and Impact

- Raising Cyber Awareness: CySI's events have contributed to raising awareness about critical cybersecurity threats, legal challenges, and victim support mechanisms.
- · Growing Engagement: A marked increase in participation across all events, with a diverse audience of professionals from IT, law enforcement, academia, and legal fields.
- Digital Outreach: Recorded videos of all major events are available on CySI's YouTube channel, with photos accessible on the CySI website, further extending our educational reach.

#### D. Administrative Activities:

- 1. The CySI bank account has been transferred to the IOB branch at LB Road, Thiruvanmiyur.
- 2. Fixed deposits previously held at various IOB branches have been consolidated and moved to the IOB branch at LB Road, Thiruvanmiyur, where our Savings Account is maintained.
- 3. A dedicated mobile phone number (98925822205) has been acquired exclusively for CySI to facilitate receipt of payments via GPay.
- 4. The Executive Committee (ECM) maintains a WhatsApp group to share updates on CySI activities among EC members. Decisions, however, are made solely during ECM and AGM meetings.
- 5. A separate WhatsApp group for interested CySI members is available for sharing cybercrime and security-related information, aimed at enhancing members' knowledge in cybercrime prevention.
- 6. The Secretary issued a show-cause notice to an Office Bearer for discussing ECM agendas via email, which was protested by the member. The member subsequently filed a case in civil court, but their petition was dismissed, and an order was issued in April 2023.

#### D. Future Outlook

Looking ahead, CySI plans to:

- Expand partnerships with academic institutions and corporate entities to enhance cybersecurity education.
- Focus on organizing more technical workshops and certifications for young professionals entering the cybersecurity space.
- Strengthen its financial standing by pursuing grants and increasing membership engagement.
- To secure funding and attract more active live members, we have fully revised the CySI Bye-Laws, originally formulated two decades ago, with the exception of a few amendments made in 2011, while preserving the core objectives. These revisions, based on our collective experiences, will be presented at the AGM for discussion, with the possibility of further additions or deletions. Our goal is to rejuvenate CySI. To save our time, we have provided the current Bye-Laws and the Draft CySI Bye-Laws in soft copy, instead of the original format with side-by-side comparisons. We encourage members to review both documents and offer feedback, helping us shape the CySI Bye-Laws into a model for all NGOs committed to nonprofit work.




