





Virtual Extraordinary General Body Meeting (EGM)
Dated 19.01.2025

Minutes of the Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM)-Cyber Society of India (CySI)

Date: Sunday, 19.01. 2025, **Time:** 10.00 A.M.–12.30 PM, **Venue:** Zoom Meeting

Members Present:







- I. As per the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975, the quorum for this meeting is defined as one-third of the total members or 25 members, whichever is less. At the scheduled start time of 10:00 a.m., the quorum requirement was not met, as only 15 members were present. Consequently, the meeting was adjourned and reconvened on the same day at 10:30 a.m., during which no quorum was required under the Act.
- II. Of the 27 members who had signed the request letters dated 20.11.2024 and 18.12.2024 for an Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM), only one member, Mr. S. Chockalingam, attended. His signature was included in the letter dated 18.12.2024, which reiterated the agenda outlined in the earlier letter submitted by Mr. V. Rajendran on 20.11.2024. Dr. S. Vasudevan participated in the meeting using a device model VIVO V2202.
- III. The entire proceedings of the meeting were recorded via Zoom, converted into a YouTube video, and subsequently published alongside the official minutes of the meeting.
- IV. Special recognition was accorded to Mr. Na. Vijaya Sankar, a founding member of CySI, for his pivotal role in incorporating provisions into the CySI Bye-Laws to enable the conduct of virtual meetings. These provisions have been instrumental in saving time, reducing costs, and facilitating the seamless sharing of individual perspectives.
- V. The relevant provision in the Bye-Laws reads as follows:14. Use of Electronic Documents "The society may use electronic means for the creation, storage, receipt, or delivery of notices to the members, for the maintenance of accounts and account books, for conducting virtual meetings, or for adopting electronic voting processes for elections, or for any other requirements of the society, subject to the necessary security and authentication measures as may be required under the Information Technology Act, 2000, ITAA, 2008, and any other laws in force."

Agenda: Refer to the CySI EGM Notices dated 03.12.2024, 30.12.2024, and 18.01.2025.

- 1) Inspection of Minutes Book: The minutes of the ECM, AGM, and EGM from 2004 to 2024 have been scanned and uploaded to the CySI website at www.cysi.in for reference by all members. The upload of CySI Minutes and Audit Reports has been approved and made accessible under the archives section at https://cysi.in/archives/.
- 2) Financial Status: The meeting commenced with a welcome address by the President, Mr. Vijayakumar KM, who highlighted the importance of the agenda and emphasized the need for collective decision-making to uphold CySI's integrity and ensure its growth. He also elaborated on CySI's achievements and performance over the years. The President's speech can be viewed at https://www.youtube.com/@CyberSocietyofIndia/videos.
- 3) Removal of a life members: -The Secretary provided a detailed explanation regarding the removal of a Life Member through a PowerPoint presentation. The speech is available at https://www.youtube.com/@CyberSocietyofIndia/videos. The removal of the three members was unanimously approved by the 15 members present. It was noted that the removed members could pursue legal action if they wished, having already exhausted the option of rejoining CySI by failing to secure 75% approval in the EGM.
- 4) **Any other points: -**The Secretary presented the matters of legal notices involving CySI and the resignation of Mr. K. Srinivasan for consideration and decision.



Resolutions: -

- A. Hereafter, there should be no further discussion or reference to the removal of the three members, as their removal was carried out in accordance with the Bye Laws, and the Executive Committee ensured that due processes were followed. The affected members have the right to seek remedies through the courts and have already initiated this by sending legal notices to CySI. Office bearers and life members are advised to focus solely on CySI's activities and initiatives.
- B. CySI will address all legal notices related to the removal of the members and will take necessary action, including issuing legal notices, against any defamatory postings. This includes defamatory content uploaded by two life members regarding the Google Form intended for member registration and participation in the EGM.
- C. Mr. K. Srinivasan, Founder & Chairman of Prime Point Foundation, Publisher & Managing Editor of PreSense, Founder & Chairman of the Sansad Ratna Awards Committee, Chairman & Managing Trustee of the Digital Journalists Association of India (DiJAI), Convenor of the Education Loan Task Force (ELTF), and Administrator of the Prime Point Foundation YouTube channel, submitted his resignation letter via email to the President of CySI on 14.01.2025.

In the email, he mentioned that he did not possess a CySI ID card and was therefore unable to surrender it. He reflected on his 20 years of association with CySI but did not reference CySI Bye Law Clause 11 (C)(iv), which states: "Life membership shall be for a period of 20 years and shall expire if not renewed at the end of the financial year after the term."

As one of the Founders of CySI, he expressed his commitment to supporting the organization in the future, if needed. Based on his request, the President accepted his resignation, effective from 14.01.2025. The EGM unanimously ratified the President's decision.

Conclusion:

- Mr.K.Gopalsamy, Addl.S.P.Retired of Coimbathore, a new member thanked all the members for their active participation.
- The EGM fulfilled its intended purposes for the individuals who genuinely called for it.
- The meeting concluded at 12.30 PM.





Subject: Clarification on Election Notification - Regarding Designation of Vice Presidents and Floor Nomination

Dear Mr. C. Badri Greetings to you.

Thank you for your continued interest in upholding the democratic process and statutory compliance in the functioning of the Cyber Society of India.

With reference to your letter addressed to the Election Officer dated 24 July 2025, I wish to place on record the following clarifications after careful review of the Bye Laws and precedence established in earlier elections, specifically the 2011 Election Notification (No.Election/1 dated 02-08-2011) and the clarification issued by then President Mr. S. Balu on 25.07.2019:

1. Designation of Vice Presidents (Senior and Junior)

As per Clause 23 of the Bye Laws (Conduct of General Meetings), the Senior Vice President is not elected separately, but is designated among the two elected Vice Presidents based on seniority criteria—age first, followed by membership number.

"...such seniority shall be determined first by age and then by the membership number as per records in the register of members of the society."

This practice has been consistently followed in all past elections (including in 2011, 2013, and 2019). The 2011 election notification explicitly called for two Vice Presidents without distinguishing between Senior and Junior roles at the time of election. The seniority is determined post-election as per the Bye Law for the purpose of presiding over meetings, only when the President is absent.

Hence, the Election Officer's call for nominations for two Vice Presidents is in full compliance with the Bye Laws and established precedent.

2. Regarding "Floor Nomination"

The provision for Floor Nomination is not a deviation. In the 2011 Election Notification (Clause 7), it was clearly stated:

"Where the number of nominations received is less than the number of posts or no nomination has been received for any post, the Election Officer can accept floor nomination before commencement of the election at the venue as stated above and conduct the election."

This clearly establishes precedent and legitimacy for floor nominations in exceptional cases. This clause has remained consistent in spirit to ensure the smooth conduct of elections and to avoid vacancies in office-bearer positions due to lack of nominations.

Therefore, the Election Officer for the 2025-27 term is fully within the framework of Bye Laws and past practices by including the provision for Floor Nomination.

Conclusion

It is evident that the current Election Notification (Election/1/2025) is well-aligned with both:

- The Bye Laws of CySI as published and filed in 2011, and
- The established practice as seen in earlier elections (notably in 2011 and reaffirmed in 2019 by the then President).

We appreciate your vigilance and spirit of constructive engagement in ensuring adherence to rules. Your queries have given us an opportunity to reiterate and document these precedents for the benefit of all members and to uphold transparency in the election process.

Subject: Interpretation of Relevant Bye-law Clauses – Founder Members' Voting Rights and Election Process

In response to your representations regarding Founder Members' Voting Rights and the Election Process, and in consultation with the Election Officer, the Society's official interpretation of the relevant Bye-law clauses is provided below:

Annexure – Interpretation of Relevant Bye-law Clauses

Clause No.	Text of Bye-law	Official Interpretation
11B(i)	"The signatories to the Memorandum of Association at the time of formation of the Society shall be called 'Founder Members."	Founder Member status is a historical designation based on being a signatory at the time of the Society's incorporation. It is not, by itself, a membership category carrying perpetual voting rights unless expressly provided elsewhere in the Byelaws.
11B(viii)	"Individuals paying the prescribed fee shall be designated as 'Life Members.'"	Life Membership is conferred upon payment of the prescribed fee. Voting rights linked to Life Membership remain valid only while the membership is active and in good standing.
13(d)	"Only those members who have valid membership on the date of commencement of the election process as declared by the Election Officer and whose membership continues until the date of the election shall be eligible to vote."	Voting eligibility depends solely on holding active, valid membership during the relevant period. Founder status alone does not qualify. If membership in a voting category (e.g., life, annual, institutional) has lapsed, the individual is ineligible to vote.
13(j)	"Election may be by secret ballot or by other means to the satisfaction of the Election Officer."	The method of election is entirely at the discretion of the Election Officer. In the 2025 election cycle, only one valid nomination was received for each of the 14 EC positions, making voting unnecessary; all candidates were declared unanimously elected under this clause.

Official Interpretation

Appointment

of Election Officer (related provision) "The Election Officer shall be appointed by the Executive Committee for each election cycle."

The role of the Election Officer is not permanent; each appointment is specific to an individual election cycle and terminates automatically unless the individual is reappointed. The administration of CySI is vested in the Executive Committee, which is the custodian of the Society's records, and the Secretary is authorised to communicate on behalf of the Executive Committee. Therefore, a reply issued by the Secretary is the most appropriate.

Note: This interpretation reflects the Society's official position on the cited clauses as of the date of this correspondence. Any change to these interpretations would require a formal amendment to the Bye-laws through the prescribed procedure.
